


**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman Tre Hargett, Director Sara Kyle and Director Mary W. Freeman of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on December 15, 2008. TLX Communications, Inc. (Telamerica) (the "Company") originally filed an Application for authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications services in Tennessee on December 12, 1995. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on August 28, 1996, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On September 2, 2008 the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority.¹ Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.
