ORDER

- 1. The Petitioner is engaged in the public utility business of furnishing natural gas to customers in numerous counties in Tennessee.
- 2. The Petitioner is subject to the regulation and supervision of the Tennessee Public Service Commission pursuant to Chapter 4, Title 65 of <u>Tennessee Code Annotated</u>.
- 3. That Petitioner's proposed issuance and sale of common stock is in the public interest.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED:

- 1. That Petitioner is authorized to issue and sell up to 100,000 shares of common stock, no par value, pursuant to the terms and provisions of its Non-Employee Director Stock Plan.
- 2. That any party aggrieved with the Commission's decision in this matter may file a Petition for Reconsideration with the Commission within ten (10) days from and after the date of this Order.
- 3. That any party aggrieved with the Commission's decision in this matter has the right of judicial review by filing a Petition for Review in the Tennessee Court of Appeals, Middle Section, within sixty (60) days from and after the date of this Order.
