ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE RESELL TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES IN TENNESSEE

This matter came before Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard, Vice Chairman John Hie, Commissioner David F. Jones, Commissioner Clay R. Good, and Commissioner Kenneth C. Hill, of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the "Commission" or "TPUC"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, during a regularly scheduled Commission Conference held on July 11, 2022, to consider a request to cancel the certificate of convenience and necessity authorizing the operations of Value-Added Communications, Inc. ("Value-Added Communications" or the "Company") in the state of Tennessee.

The Company was granted authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications by the Commission on June 26, 1996. On June 24, 2022, the Commission received a request for cancellation of its certificate of authority from Value-Added Communications, Inc. The cancellation request asserted that the Company no longer has customers receiving any services for which it is required to maintain a certificate. Therefore, as there are no customers are being served, the cancellation of its

certification will have no adverse consequences for consumers in Tennessee.

Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.
