
**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman Mary W. Freeman, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Kenneth C. Hill of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on March 28, 2011. D.D.D. Calling, Inc. (the "Company") originally filed an Application for authority to resell interexchange long distance services in Tennessee on April 17, 1996. On June 26, 1996, the Tennessee Public Service Commission issued an order stating that the Company had met all the requirements for certification. On January 20, 2011, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority.¹ Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.
