ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE RESELL TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES IN TENNESSEE

This matter came before Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard, Vice Chairman David F. Jones, Commissioner David Crowell, Commissioner Kenneth C. Hill, and Commissioner John Hie of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the "Commission" or "TPUC"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, during a regularly scheduled Commission Conference held on May 8, 2023. Windstream NTI, LLC (formerly known as Norlight, Inc.) ("Company") was granted authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications by the Commission on August 13, 1996.

On January 8, 2021, the Commission received a request for cancellation of authority from Windstream NTI, LLC. The cancellation request asserted that the company no longer has customers receiving any services for which it is required to maintain a certificate. Therefore, as there are no customers being served, the cancellation of its certification will have no adverse consequences for consumers in Tennessee.
