TO PROVIDE RESOLD TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**


This matter came before Chairman David F. Jones, Commissioner Herbert H. Hilliard, and Commissioner Kenneth C. Hill of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the "Commission" or "TPUC"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, during a regularly scheduled Commission Conference held on January 16, 2018. TTI National, Inc. ("TTI" or the "Company") filed an Application for authority to resell telecommunications services in Tennessee on June 10, 1996. On June 26, 1996, the Tennessee Public Service Commission issued an order stating that TTI had met all the requirements for certification.

On November 2, 2017, TPUC received a request from the Company to cancel its authority. TTI stated that its customers were transferred to MCI Communications Services, Inc. d/b/a Verizon Business Services, effective November 1, 2017, and that TTI no longer has any customers or operations in Tennessee. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Commissioners voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.
