The undersigned, for the purposes of incorporating and organizing a corporation under the General Corporation Law of the State of Delaware, do execute this Certificate of Incorporation and do hereby certify as follows:

FIRST: The name of the corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation") is Five Star Telecom, Inc.

SECOND: The address of the registered office of the Corporation in the State of Delaware is 15 E. North Street, in the City of Dover, County of Kent. The name of its registered agent at that address is Incorporating Services, Ltd.

THIRD: The purpose of the Corporation is to engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be organized under the General Corporation Law of the State of Delaware (the "GCL").

FOURTH: The total number of shares which the Corporation shall have authority to issue is 10,000 shares of Common Stock, par value \$.01 per share.

FIFTH: The incorporator of the Corporation is Leslie J. Barnett, whose mailing address is 601 Bayshore Boulevard, Suite 700, Tampa, Florida 33606.

SIXTH: Each holder of any of the shares of the capital stock of the Corporation shall be entitled to a preemptive right to purchase or subscribe for any unissued stock of any class or nay additional shares of any class to be issued by reason of any increase of the authorized capital stock of the Corporation of any class, or bonds, certificates of indebtedness, debentures or other securities convertible into stock of the Corporation, or carrying any rights to purchase stock of any class, whether said unissued stock shall be issued for cash, property, or any other lawful consideration.

SEVENTH: No director of the Corporation shall be liable to the Corporation or its stockholders for monetary damages for reach of fiduciary duty as a director, except for liability (i) for any breach of the director's duty of loyalty to the Corporation or its stockholders, (ii) for acts or omissions not in good faith or which involve intentional misconduct or a knowing violation of law, (iii) pursuant to Section 174 of the GCL or (iv) for any transaction from which the director derived an improper personal benefit. If the GCL is hereafter amended to

authorize the further elimination or limitation of the liability of a director, then the liability of a director of the Corporation shall be eliminated or limited to the fullest extent permitted by the GCL, as so amended. Any repeal or modification of this Article SEVENTH by the stockholders of the Corporation shall not adversely affect any right or protection of a director of the Corporation existing at the time of such repeal or modification with respect to any acts or omissions occurring prior to such repeal or modification. The provisions of this Article SEVENTH shall not be deemed to limit or preclude indemnification of a director by the Corporation for any liability of a director that has not been eliminated or limited by the provisions of this Article SEVENTH.

EIGHTH: In furtherance and not in limitation of the powers conferred by the laws of the State of Delaware, the Board of Directors is expressly authorized to make, amend and repeal the by-laws, except to the extent that the by-laws or this Certificate of Incorporation otherwise provide. The business and affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by or under the direction of the Board of Directors, and the Directors need not be elected by ballot unless required by the by-laws of the Corporation.

NINTH: The Corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change or repeal any provisions contained in this Certificate of Incorporation, in the manner now or hereafter prescribed by statute, and all rights conferred upon stockholders herein are granted subject to this reservation.
