PETITION FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE

Citizens Telecommunications Company of Tennessee, L.L.C. ("CTC-TN"), by its attorney, hereby petitions for leave to intervene in the above-styled proceeding and, in support thereof, respectfully shows as follows:

- 1. CTC-TN is an incumbent local exchange carrier in Tennessee. Like United Telephone Southeast, Inc., it has elected price regulation pursuant to T.C.A. §65-5-209.
- 2. As the first price regulation plan pricing adjustment filing in Tennessee, the subject United Telephone Southeast, Inc. may establish precedent in the treatment of future pricing adjustments by CTC-TN and other incumbent local exchange carriers that have elected pricing regulation. According, CTC-TN has an interest in the outcome of this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, Citizens Telecommunications Company of Tennessee, L.L.C. respectfully prays that it be granted intervenor status in this proceeding.
