


**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY  
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**



This matter came before the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority") at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on February 27, 2012. T-NETIX, Inc. (the "Company") originally filed an Application for authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications services in Tennessee on December 5, 1996. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on February 4, 1997, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On February 13, 2012, the Authority received a request from the Company to cancel its authority.<sup>1</sup> Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.
