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interconnection with incumbent local telephone companies and new carriers, that BellSouth will in a reasonable amount of time be asking for consideration to get into the long distance business under the sections of Section 271 of the Federal Act.

In anticipation of that and the fact that the FCC is required to act on such a request within 90 says and to consult with state commissions in preparation making that recommendation, we're asking for the directors to authorize the staff to begin an investigation of BellSouth's compliance requirements of this provision of the Act and to report back to you with comments from the effected parties by February 18th of this year, next year, excuse me. We're fast, but not that fast.

CHAIRMAN GREER: Say that again. I'm sorry.

DR. LYONS: We're asking you to authorize the staff to begin an investigation into BellSouth's compliance with the requirements for entry into the in-region interLATA long distance service pursuant to Section 271 of the Federal Telecommunications Act and to issue a report to you on the status of things by February 18th, 1997.

CHAIRMAN GREER: I'll so move.

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1 DIRECTOR MALONE: I'll second the 2 motion. 3 DIRECTOR KYLE: Yes, I'm in 4 agreement. 5 CHAIRMAN GREER: Our general counsel 6 has spoken with those parties who are involved in 7 Docket No. 96-1423, and that is the Sprint/United 8 price cap regulation preconference hearing that was 9 held this past week. And they have waived notice to 10 take care of one issue. We are going to finish that preconference hearing this afternoon at 1:30 in this 11 room, but there's one item that needs to be taken care 12 13 of. And all parties have agreed to a revised 14 protective order. And as the hearing officer, I make a motion that we approve the revised protective order 15 16 and the protective order is exactly the same with the exception of changing the names as to the protective 17 order that was used in the avoidable cost hearing. I 18 19 so move. DIRECTOR MALONE: I'll second the 20 21 motion. Fine with me. DIRECTOR KYLE: 22 CHAIRMAN GREER: That's unanimous. 23 24 We're going to take a five-minute break and then we'll be back to pick up on 25
