The parties to this action are hereby advised that, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-5-313(6) and § 65-2-109(4), the Authority is taking judicial notice of specific facts and material as follows:

1. The Consumer Price Index ("CPI") average annual change since 1997 is 2.4 %.
2. The Gross Domestic Product – Price Index ("GDP-PI") average annual change since 1997 is 1.3%.
3. The three-year US Treasury Bond rate has been between 5 and 6 percent since 1997.

These facts were found on the web sites for the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics; U.S. Department of Commerce, Bureau of Economic Analysis; and the Federal Reserve Board. Copies of these materials are attached to this notice.
