**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY  
TO PROVIDE RESOLD TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

---

This matter came before Vice Chair Kenneth C. Hill, Commissioner Herbert H. Hilliard, and Commissioner David F. Jones of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the “Commission” or “TPUC”), the voting panel assigned to this docket, during a regularly scheduled Commission Conference held on October 14, 2019. Net One International, Inc., formerly International Charity Network, Inc., (“Net One” or the “Company”) was granted authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications by the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) on July 9, 1997 in Docket No. 97-01117.

The last inspection fee from Net One International, Inc. was received on March 23, 2015 for the 2014 inspection fee period. Since 2016, all correspondence sent to the company by both regular and certified mail has been returned marked “not deliverable as addressed.” Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the

Commissioners voted unanimously to cancel the Company's authority for failure to pay its inspection fees.
