**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE
CUSTOMER OWNED COIN OR COINLESS OPERATED TELEPHONE SERVICE**

This matter came before Vice Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard, Director Kenneth C. Hill and Director David F. Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority" or "TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on June 17, 2013. Kentucky Coin Pay Phones, Inc. (the "Company") filed an Application to provide Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone ("COCOT") service within the State of Tennessee in 1997. During an Authority Conference held on March 24, 1998, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-2-.43 through 1220-4-2-.45 to provide COCOT service in Tennessee and approved the Application. On May 2, 2013, the TRA received a request from the Company to cancel its authority. Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.
