This will provide a formal notice, pursuant to Tennessee Comprehensive Rules & Regulations No. 1220-4-8-.05, that Qwest Interprises America (QIA), a wholly owned subsidiary of Qwest Communications International, Inc., intends to abandon its certificates of operating authority for all telecommunications services in the state of Tennessee effective 90 days after this filing as required by the above-referenced regulation.

QIA is certificated to provide interexchange and competitive local services in Tennessee. It also has tariffs on file with the Tennessee Regulatory Authority.
