

ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

This matter came before Chairman Sara Kyle, Director Pat Miller and Director Ron Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on November 6, 2006. Go-Comm, Inc.¹ (the "Company") originally filed an Application for authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications services in Tennessee on August 29, 1997. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on October 21, 1997, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-2-.57, which was promulgated pursuant to, *inter alia*, Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-2-102 and Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-201, and approved the Application. On October 6, 2006, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority.² Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.

¹ Go-Comm, Inc. was formerly known as Go-Tel, Inc. This name change was effected by Order dated April 3, 2001 (Docket No. 01-00224).

² On October 6, 2006, the TRA received notification from Airband Communications, Inc. that it purchased Go-Comm, Inc. on or about May 4, 2004. Prior to the purchase, Go-Comm, Inc. had not done business in Tennessee for several years, and Airband Communications, Inc. does not intend to conduct business in Tennessee.
