ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE RESELL TELECOMMUNICATION SERVICES

This matter came before Chairman David F. Jones, Vice Chairman John Hie, Commissioner Herbert H. Hilliard, Commissioner Robin L. Morrison, and Commissioner Kenneth C. Hill of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the “Commission” or “TPUC”), the voting panel assigned to this docket, during a regularly scheduled Commission Conference held on December 8, 2025. On March 1, 1998, the Tennessee Regulatory Authority, now TPUC, issued an order granting Network Communications International Corporation (“Network Communications” or “Company”) a CCN to provide operator services and/or resell local telecommunications services.¹ On June 24, 2025, the Commission received a request from the Company to cancel its CCN because it does not serve any customers under this authority. The Company is in good standing with the Commission and current in its payment of mandatory inspection fees. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Commissioners voted unanimously to grant the Company’s request to cancel its CCN.
