**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard, Vice Chairman David F. Jones and Director Kenneth C. Hill of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on October 19, 2015. Americatel Corporation d/b/a 10 123 Americatel d/b/a 1010 123 Americatel ("Americatel" or the "Company") filed an Application for authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications services in Tennessee on January 26, 1998. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on February 2, 1999, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application.

On August 11, 2015, the Authority received a request from Americatel to cancel its authority. The Company stated that its customers were transferred to Matrix Telecom, Inc. d/b/a Matrix Business Technologies d/b/a Excel Telecommunications d/b/a VarTec Telecom, effective December 30, 2014, and that Americatel has ceased operations in Tennessee. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
