
Dear Mr. Murphy:

On February 28, 2006, the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("Authority" or "TRA") received a request to cancel the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") of Verizon Avenue Corp. ("VAC").¹ This request was granted during the May 15, 2006 Authority Conference and an order was issued on June 7, 2006.

In reviewing the history of OnePoint and VAC, it came to TRA Staff's attention that OnePoint was granted authority to resell interexchange long distance service by the TRA in Docket No. 98-00501. VAC's request to cancel stated the Authority approved the transfer of all of OnePoint's assets to VAC in Docket No. 03-00523, however, only requested cancellation of the CCN granted in Docket No. 00-00112 and did not address the CCN granted to OnePoint in Docket No. 98-00501.

Please advise the TRA whether VAC plans to maintain the CCN to provide resold interexchange long distance service, or in the alternative, file a request to cancel the authority granted in Docket No. 98-00501.

¹ The CCN was originally granted to OnePoint Communications-Georgia, LLC ("OnePoint") in Docket No. 00-00112. On September 16, 2003, OnePoint filed a petition for a name change in Docket No. 03-00523. On February 17, 2004, OnePoint and VAC filed a Joint Petition amending the original filing in Docket No. 03-00523 to reflect a corporate reorganization and transfer of assets from OnePoint to VAC. The transfer in Docket 03-00523 was approved by the Authority on March 22, 2004.
