ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

This matter came before Director Eddie Roberson, Director Pat Miller and Director Ron Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on November 6, 2006. OnePoint Communications-Georgia, LLC (the "Company") was granted authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications services in Tennessee during a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on October 20, 1998. The Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-2-.57, which was promulgated pursuant to, *inter alia*, Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-2-102 and Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-201. On May 6, 2004, an Order was issued in Docket No. 03-00523 approving a transaction whereby the assets and Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity of the Company were transferred to Verizon Avenue Corp. On October 12, 2006, Verizon Avenue Corp. requested that the TRA cancel its authority.¹ Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant Verizon Avenue Corp.'s request to cancel its authority.
