


**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Director Mary W. Freeman, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Kenneth C. Hill of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on February 22, 2010. An Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide facilities-based and resold local exchange, exchange access and interexchange telecommunication services in Tennessee was filed by NA Communications, Inc. (the "Company") in 1998. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on August 10, 1999, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On December 7, 2009, the Company requested that the Authority cancel its CCN. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its CCN.
