Dear Ms. Dillon:

ALEC LLC ("ALEC") (CLEC ID No. 128220), through counsel, hereby provides notice to the Commission of its intent to discontinue the provision of telecommunications services effective March 31, 2018, or as soon as all regulatory approvals have been obtained.

Accordingly, ALEC requests cancellation of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") no later than March 31, 2018. No consumers will be impacted by this discontinuance as ALEC has no end-user customers. Its only customer is an affiliate whom it serves on a wholesale basis. A copy of the notice provided to the ALEC's customer is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

In support of this filing, ALEC submits the following information:

I. Request to Cancel Certificate

ALEC was granted a CCN to provide intrastate Telecommunications Services in Tennessee on May 11, 1999 in Docket No. 98-00599. ALEC respectfully requests that the Commission cancel its CCN as well as any tariffs that may be on file.

II. Customer Notice

ALEC is an exclusively wholesale service provider and its only customers is an internal affiliate. Notice has been provided to that customer, which has made alternative arrangements for service. A copy of the Notice is attached as Exhibit A. No end-user customers will be impacted by this discontinuance.

III. Notice of FCC Discontinuance Filing

ALEC has filed an application with the FCC under 47 C.F.R. § 63.71 to discontinue the domestic interstate services provided as part of its service offering. A copy of that Application (as supplemented) is attached as Exhibit B. This pleading is intended to constitutes notice of and service on the Commission of ALEC's Section 63.71 filing of as required by 47 C.F.R. § 63.71(a).

WHEREFORE,

ALEC respectfully requests that its CCN be cancelled and that the Commission take all other appropriate action to effectuate this request.

ALEC plans to discontinue the services that are the subject of this Application on or about March 31, 2018, pending federal and state regulatory approval.

3. Points of Geographic Areas of Service Affected:

ALEC proposes to discontinue providing service in the following jurisdictions: Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Idaho, Illinois, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, Nevada, North Carolina, Ohio, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, and Wisconsin. If the Application is granted, ALEC will no longer provide service anywhere in the United States.

4. Brief Description of Types of Service Affected and Reason for Discontinuance:

ALEC is considered non-dominant in all locations it serves with respect to the service that will be discontinued.

7. Other Information.
