These Articles of Incorporation are evidence that the undersigned incorporator has declared its intention of forming a corporation pursuant to Chapter 271B of the Kentucky Revised Statutes and all other acts amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be Unique Coin & Collectibles, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The total number of shares of stock authorized to be issued shall be 1,000 shares of no par common stock.

ARTICLE III
