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**ORDER REVOKING AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE COCOT SERVICES  
IN TENNESSEE FOR NON-PAYMENT OF FEES**

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This matter came before Chairman Eddie Roberson, Director Sara Kyle and Director Ron Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (“TRA”), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on January 28, 2008 to cancel the authority of Total Telephone Concepts, Inc. (the “Company”) to offer Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone (“COCOT”) service in Tennessee due to non-payment of fees.

The Company originally filed an Application to provide COCOT service within the State of Tennessee on October 12, 1998. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on November 17, 1998, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-2-.43 through 1220-4-2-.45 to provide COCOT service in Tennessee and approved the Application.<sup>1</sup>

Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-301(b) (2004), every owner or operator of a public pay telephone shall submit to the TRA an annual inspection and supervision fee for each service

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
<sup>1</sup> The Company’s authority to provide COCOT service in Tennessee was revoked due to non-payment of fees at an Authority Conference held on November 20, 2006. The Company subsequently paid its fees, and its authority was reinstated at an Authority Conference held on January 8, 2007. *See Order Reinstating Authority to Provide COCOT Services in Tennessee* (May 31, 2007).

location on or before July 1 of each year. The Company was notified by mail on April 9, 2007 and July 16, 2007 of its failure to comply with the requirements of Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-301(b) (2004). Notices of Cancellation were mailed on August 10, 2007 and September 28, 2007 via certified mail. The Company failed to respond. As a result of that failure, this matter was placed on the January 28, 2008 Authority Conference for the panel to consider revocation of the Company's authority to provide COCOT service due to non-payment of fees.


Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to revoke the authority of the Company to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.<sup>2</sup>

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**


