
Re: Docket No. 1100166 – Joint Petition of DSLnet Communications, LLC, and DIECA Communications, Inc. Concerning Certain *Pro Forma* Intra-Corporate Transactions – CONSUMMATION NOTICE AND REQUEST TO CANCEL AUTHORITY

Dear Chairman Hill:

DIECA Communications, Inc. d/b/a Covad Communications Company (“DIECA”), on its own behalf and as successor in interest to DSLnet Communications, LLC (“DSLnet,” and together with DIECA, the “Parties”), notify the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (“TRA”) that on December 31, 2011, DSLnet and DIECA completed a *pro forma* transaction whereby DSLnet merged with and into DIECA with DIECA surviving the merger.¹

As a result of the *pro forma* transaction, DSLnet no longer exists as a separate entity, no longer offers services in Tennessee and therefore no longer requires its authorizations. As such, the Parties hereby request that the TRA cancel DSLnet’s authorizations to provide intrastate telecommunications and rescind any and all tariffs on file with the TRA. In Tennessee, DSLnet was granted a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity as a Competing Telecommunications Service Provider pursuant to the Order issued by the Authority in Docket No. 99-00092 on June 4, 1999. Because DSLnet does not serve any intrastate telecommunications customers in Tennessee, the Company respectfully submits that the surrender of its authorizations is reasonable and necessary and will not be disruptive to the present or future public interest, convenience and necessity.
