RE: Docket No: 99-00120 – Global Crossing Local Services, Inc. and Global Crossing Telecommunications, Inc. Formal Notice of Discontinuance of Voice Telecommunications Services

The agency received a letter on February 17, 2025, that was assigned to TPUC Docket 99-00120. The letter indicates that on or after September 16, 2025, Global Crossing Telecommunications, Inc. and Global Crossing Local Services, Inc. (together “Global Crossing”) will cease providing voice telecommunications services. The letter clearly indicates that Global Crossing is exiting only the voice telecommunication market and will continue to provide access services. As such, Global Crossing does not seek to abandon its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity; instead, it only seeks to discontinue the provision of voice service.

Global Crossing elected market regulation via a letter filed November 15, 2016, that was assigned to TPUC Docket Number 16-00134. T.C.A. § 65-5-109(n) provides a description of the regulatory requirements that apply to companies that elect Market Regulation. The approval of discontinuing voice service is not a regulatory requirement applicable to companies that have elected Market Regulation. As such, the transaction described in the correspondence dated May 30, 2025, does not require approval. As no action is required by the agency, please close the above-referenced docket.
