

**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Director Eddie Roberson, Director Pat Miller and Director Ron Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on June 25, 2007. An Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide intrastate telecommunications services in Tennessee was filed by Alltel Communications, Inc. (the "Company") on April 13, 1999. During a Hearing held on May 18, 1999, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On May 17, 2007, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its CCN. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its CCN.¹
