**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman Mary W. Freeman, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Kenneth C. Hill of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on January 24, 2011. An Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide intrastate telecommunications services in Tennessee was filed by Global NAPs Gulf, Inc. (the "Company") in 1999. During an Authority Conference held on May 18, 1999, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On December 8, 2009, the Authority received a request to cancel the Company's CCN.¹ Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its CCN.


