CUSTOMER OWNED COIN OR COINLESS OPERATED TELEPHONE SERVICE**



This matter came before Chairman Sara Kyle, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Pat Miller of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on June 25, 2007. Andrew Johnson Golf Club (the "Company") originally filed an Application to provide Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone ("COCOT") service within the State of Tennessee on May 18, 1999. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on June 8, 1999, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-2-.43 through 1220-4-2-.45 to provide COCOT service in Tennessee and approved the Application. On May 23, 2007, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority to provide COCOT service in Tennessee. Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to cancel, by request, the authority of Andrew Johnson Golf Club to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.
