Response: Legacy Long Distance International, Inc. offers outbound telecommunications services to residential and business Customers utilizing switched access via Feature Group D circuits. Customers may choose to use dedicated facilities for call origination.. Legacy offers an inward WATS service. This service permits termination of interstate and intrastate calls from diverse geographic locations to customer local exchange lines or to dedicated access facilities. When an 800 "toll free" service is used, Legacy's customer is billed for the call rather than the call originator. The primary customers of Legacy's operator assisted services are companies who in their normal course of business are responsible for providing access and directing telephone calls for large number of end users. Legacy's operator assisted services permit callers to place calls using optional billing methods (i.e. collect, third party, or to a calling/credit card). Applicant also offers operator assistance for person-to-person calling or for operator dialing assistance.

- N. What is the applicant's 10XXX or 800 access code?

Response: The Company does not have a 10XXX code, nor does it offer presubscribed services via an 800 access code.

- O. Does the applicant now have or plan to have any telecommunications facilities (e.g. switches, fiber lines) in Tennessee?

Response: No. Legacy Long Distance International, Inc. proposes to operate as a switchless reseller.

- P. What facility-based network will the applicant be reselling?

Response: MCI/WorldCom.




