**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE RESOLD TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman Kenneth C. Hill, Vice Chair Herbert H. Hilliard, and Commissioner John Hie of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the “Commission” or “TPUC”), the voting panel assigned to this docket, during a regularly scheduled Commission Conference held on September 14, 2020. Legacy Long Distance International, Inc. (“Legacy” or the “Company”) was granted authority to provide operator services and/or resale telecommunications by the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) on August 24, 1999 in Docket No. 99-00423. A final order was issued on August 24, 1999.¹

On September 3, 2020, the Commission received a notice of voluntary relinquishment and request for cancellation of authority from Legacy. The notice requested cancellation of the authority of the Company to provide local and long-distance resale telecommunications services granted in Docket Nos. 99-00423 and 17-00001, effective as soon as possible, and withdrawal of any tariffs on file. The cancellation request noted that Legacy no longer has customers in

Tennessee.

Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Commissioners voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.
