**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE
CUSTOMER OWNED COIN OR COINLESS OPERATED TELEPHONE SERVICE**

This matter came before Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard, Commissioner David F. Jones, Commissioner Kenneth C. Hill, Commissioner David Crowell, and Commissioner John Hie of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the “Commission”), the voting panel assigned to this docket, during a regularly scheduled Commission Conference held on September 11, 2023. Securus Technologies, LLC (the “Company”) was granted authority to provide Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone (“COCOT”) service within the State of Tennessee by final order issued in this docket on August 10, 1999. On July 27, 2023, the Company requested to cancel its authority to provide COCOT services in Tennessee. Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the Commissioners voted unanimously to grant the Company’s request to cancel its authority to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.
