Monthly NXX Code Request Report of The North American
Numbering Plan Administrator For January 2002

Dear Mr. Waddell:

The North American Numbering Plan Administrator NeuStar, Inc. ("NANPA"), in its role as the neutral third party administrator under the North American Numbering Plan ("NANP") and in response to a request by the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("Authority"), files an original and 13 copies of the enclosed monthly report for January 2002 containing public information regarding requests for NXX codes in the 423, 615 and 901/731 area codes.

On December 10, 1999, the Authority requested that NANPA "regularly report to the Authority the names of telecommunications service providers requesting NXX codes in the 615 and 901 area codes, together with the number of NXX codes requested."¹ The Authority subsequently requested that NANPA include similar information for the 423 area code. Pursuant to Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") regulations, NANPA performs its NXX code administration functions in

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accordance with industry guidelines.² Pursuant to industry guidelines, NANPA is required to treat as confidential NXX code request information submitted by service providers until the assigned code holder (service provider) inputs the requested NXX into the Routing Data Base System ("RDBS") and Business Rating Input Database System ("BRIDS").³ After the service provider inputs the information into RDBS and BRIDS, the assignment of the NXX becomes public information. Generally, the service provider has seven days after the assignment is made to input the assigned NXX code information into RDBS and BRIDS.⁴ Occasionally, service providers are permitted to take up to sixty-one days to input this information. During this interval, NANPA cannot provide information regarding NXX code assignments. Denials or suspensions of NXX code requests are not submitted to RDBS / BRIDS.

Enclosed is a summary of the NXX activity within the 423, 615 and 901/731 area codes during January 2002. All information provided in the report is public information. Please date-stamp the enclosed return copy as received and return it in the attached self-addressed stamped envelope.
