Monthly NXX Code Request Report of The North American
Numbering Plan Administrator For July 2000

Dear Mr. Waddell:

The North American Numbering Plan Administrator NeuStar, Inc. ("NANPA"), in its role as the neutral third party administrator under the North American Numbering Plan ("NANP") and in response to a request by the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("Authority") files the attached monthly report for July 2000 containing public information regarding requests for NXX codes in the 615 and 901 area codes.

On December 10, 1999, the Authority requested that NANPA "regularly report to the Authority the names of telecommunications service providers requesting NXX codes in the 615 and 901 area codes, together with the number of NXX codes requested."¹ Pursuant to Federal Communications Commission regulations, NANPA performs its NXX code administration functions in accordance with industry guidelines.² Pursuant to industry guidelines, NANPA is required to treat as confidential NXX code request

information submitted by service providers until the assigned code holder (service provider) inputs the requested NXX into the Routing Data Base System ("RDBS") and Business Rating Input Database System ("BRIDS").³ After the service provider inputs the information into RDBS and BRIDS, the assignment of the NXX is public information. Generally, the service provider has seven days after the assignment is made to input the assigned NXX code information into RDBS and BRIDS.⁴ Occasionally, service providers may take up to sixty-one days to input this information. During this interval, NANPA cannot provide information regarding NXX code assignments. Denials or suspensions of NXX code requests are not submitted to RDBS / BRIDS.

Below is a summary of the NXX activity within the 615 and 901 area codes during the month of July 2000. All of the NXX assignments submitted to NANPA during July have been entered into RDBS and BRIDS and are listed in this report. All information provided in this report is public information.

615 NPA – July 2000 Report

- Six service providers submitted a total of 47* Central Office Code Assignment Request Forms during July 2000.
- Of the 47 request forms, 32 NXX assignments were made, 13 change requests to existing NXX codes were processed, 1 application was denied for not complying with procedures and 1 NXX return request was processed.
- All 32 NXX assignments are now public information. See the attached report for a list of the service providers and NXX assignments. The NXX return also is public information, but the NXX will not be available for assignment until the effective disconnect date of October 25, 2000.

901 NPA – July 2000 Report

- Four service providers submitted a total of 27* Central Office Code Assignment Request Forms during July 2000.
- Of the 27 request forms, 8 NXX assignments were made, 17 change requests to existing NXX codes were processed and 3 requests were denied pursuant to the jeopardy procedures which allow for the monthly assignment of 8 NXX codes.
- All 8 of the assignments are now public information. See the attached report for a list of the service providers and NXX assignments.


