
ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY  
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

This matter came before Chairman Sara Kyle, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Pat Miller of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on April 30, 2007. Cat Communications International, Inc. (the "Company") originally filed an Application for authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications services in Tennessee on November 19, 1999. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on February 15, 2000, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-2-.57, which was promulgated pursuant to, *inter alia*, Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-2-102 and Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-201, and approved the Application. On February 5, 2007, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.<sup>1</sup>
