ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

This matter came before Vice Chairman David F. Jones, Director Kenneth C. Hill and Director Robin Bennett of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on February 9, 2015. NYNEX Long Distance Company d/b/a Bell Atlantic Business Services (the "Company") filed an Application for authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications services in Tennessee on December 7, 1999. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on February 1, 2000, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. A name change to NYNEX Long Distance Company d/b/a Verizon Enterprise Solutions was approved by the Authority on August 1, 2000 in Docket No. 00-00613. On June 15, 2009, a name change to Verizon Enterprise Solutions, LLC was approved by the Authority in Docket No. 09-00066.

On November 24, 2014, the Authority received a request from the Company to cancel its authority, stating that its customers were transferred to Verizon Long Distance, LLC on November 15, 2014. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.
