JOINT PETITION OF FORD MOTOR COMPANY AND VISTEON CORPORATION FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE

Ford Motor Company ("Ford") and Visteon Corporation ("Visteon") (jointly "Petitioners"), pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated § 4-5-310, hereby petition the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA" or the "Authority") for leave to intervene in the above referenced proceeding and to participate as their interests may appear. In support of this Petition, Ford and Visteon state the following:

- 1. Ford is a Delaware corporation authorized to do business in the State of Tennessee.
- 2. Visteon, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Ford, is a Delaware corporation, authorized to do business in the State of Tennessee, and currently operates a glass plant in Nashville (the "Glass Plant").
- 3. Ford and Piedmont Natural Gas Company, Inc. ("Piedmont") are parties to a certain Gas Redelivery Agreement executed in January, 1998 as a bypass deferral measure. Pursuant to such Agreement, Piedmont and Ford agreed that neither party would request the TRA to change the rates under the Agreement

during the term of the Agreement. This Agreement was approved by the TRA on March 12, 1999.

- 4. This Agreement is in the process of being assigned from Ford to Visteon. Visteon is also in the process of becoming an independent entity, separate from Ford. Such separation between the parent, Ford, and subsidiary, Visteon, is likely to occur before this docket is closed.
- 5. Any increase of the rates of Nashville Gas Company approved by the TRA may affect the terms of the Agreement and the operations of the Glass Plant. Therefore, Petitioners' legal interests may be determined in this proceeding and their interests will not be adequately represented unless the Authority allows the Petitioners to intervene.
- 6. The interests of justice and the orderly and prompt conduct of the proceedings will be not impaired by the intervention of Ford and Visteon.
- 7. A hearing date has been set in this docket for June 5-8, 2000. Thus, this Petition to Intervene, being filed at least seven (7) days prior to the hearing, is timely filed.

WHEREFORE, Petitioners pray:

- 1. That they be permitted to intervene in this proceeding and participate as parties as their interests may appear and to receive copies of all notices, orders and other documents issued or filed in this docket.
- 2. That Petitioners be granted such other and further relief to which they are entitled.
