ORDER RE-SUSPENDING TARIFF THROUGH AUGUST 17, 2026

This matter is before the Administrative Judge of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “TPUC”) designated by General Counsel to administer certain preliminary issues that may arise during the preparation of this matter for hearing before the Commission. On January 14, 2026, in accordance with Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-5-103 *et seq.*, Tennessee-American Water Company (“TAWC” or the “Company”) filed its Revised Sheet No. 12-ICR-11, Classification of Service, Summary of Riders, (“Revised Riders Tariff Sheet”) making changes to the Production Costs and Other Pass-Throughs Rider (“PCOP Rider”). The Revised Riders Tariff Sheet was filed with an issued date of January 14, 2025, and an effective date of February 13, 2025.¹


Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-5-103(a) permits the Commission, pending a hearing and determination, to suspend any rate increase, change, or alteration for an initial period not to exceed three months from the proposed effective date of such increase, change, or alteration and for an

additional period not to exceed nine months.² The Administrative Judge initially suspended the tariff until May 13, 2026. However, because the Commission’s investigation, hearing, and final determination on the Company’s proposed tariff cannot be completed by that date, the Administrative Judge hereby re-suspends the effectiveness of the tariff through August 17, 2026.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

The effective date of the proposed Revised Sheet No. 12-ICR-11, TPUC Tariff Number 20, filed by Tennessee-American Water Company on January 14, 2026, is hereby re-suspended through August 17, 2026, or until further order of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission, whichever occurs sooner.
