RE: Docket No: 26-00005 –Post-Closing Notification Regarding The Transfer Of Indirect Control Of Knology Of Tennessee, Inc. To Bandit MidCo Inc.

The agency received a letter on January 13, 2026, that was assigned to TPUC Docket 26-00005. The letter describes a transaction that results in the indirect transfer of control of Knology of Tennessee, Inc. (“Knology”).

Knology elected market regulation via a letter filed on October 13, 2009, which was assigned to TPUC Docket Number 09-00170. T.C.A. § 65-5-109(n) outlines the regulatory requirements applicable to companies that opt for market regulation. The transfer of control, as described, is governed by T.C.A. § 65-4-113, which is not a regulatory requirement applicable to companies that have elected market regulation. As such, the transaction described in the correspondence dated January 13, 2026, does not require approval. As no action is required by the agency, please close the above-referenced docket.
