ORDER ON MAY 8, 2026, STATUS CONFERENCE

This matter came before the Administrative Judge during a Status Conference held via videoconference on May 8, 2026, on the *Petition of Atmos Energy Corporation for Approval of Its 2026 Annual Rate Review Mechanism Filing Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. 65-5-103(d)(6)* (“*Petition*”). The Status Conference was convened at the expedited request of the Parties to discuss the issues relating to the filing of documents concerning a proposed settlement agreement of the Parties.

The Parties represented that they have had fruitful settlement discussions and have reached an agreement that resolves all contested issues in this docket. However, due to time constraints, the Parties are unable to file a fully executed Settlement Agreement prior to the settlement agreement filing deadline of May 8, 2026, at 2:00 p.m. established in the Procedural Schedule. Following presentation and discussion of the Parties and Commission Staff, the Parties agreed as follows:

1. The Parties shall file a letter outlining the parameters of the settlement, attaching schedules and calculations necessary for Commission Staff review by the close

of business on May 8, 2026. Confidential information shall be filed with the appropriate designation.

2. The Parties shall provide an unexecuted copy of the Settlement Agreement to Commission Staff by the close of business on May 8, 2026.

3. An executed Settlement Agreement shall be filed by the close of business on Wednesday, May 13, 2026. If additional time is necessary, the Parties shall notify the Commission.

4. Upon review of settlement documents, Commission Staff will communicate with Atmos Energy Corporation concerning the data request filed on May 7, 2026, with further information on whether the requested data is needed.

The Administrative Judge finds that the agreement on the filing of documents related to the proposed settlement among the Parties and the provision of and communications concerning documents, necessary schedules, and requested data among the Parties and Commission Staff is reasonable. Therefore, the Administrative Judge approves the filing of settlement agreement documentation as described hereinabove.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED.
