REQUEST:

Provide all unredacted documentation supporting the Company's \$255,059 outside services expenses associated with Traveler's (invoice # INV222717) for an injuries and damages settlement recorded during the ARRM's historical reconciliation period.

RESPONSE:

The Traveler's expense dated July 2, 2025, in the amount of \$255,059 is comprised of payments related to two claims related to motor vehicle accidents. The first was a claim filed by Fessler Home Improvement for a total expense of \$250,588.19. The second was a claim filed by Carol McDonald for a total expense of \$4,470.55. See bookmarked confidential Attachment 1 that shows the information in Atmos Energy's "Claims Paid including Claims Handling Charge" database.

The \$250,588.19 is comprised of:

\$225,000.00 / settlement payment
\$3,841.50 / Spicer Rudstrom PLLC legal fees
\$21,746.69 / Claim Handling Charge

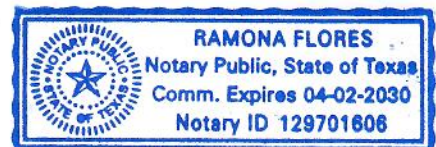
