Dear Mr. Welch:

On February 24, 2026, I issued a *Notice of Filing* in Docket No. 26-00010 requiring Aqua Green Utility, Inc. ("Aqua Green") to obtain legal representation to proceed with this matter. Tennessee law requires that corporate entities be represented by counsel in contested case matters, therefore, Mr. Dart Kendall, President of Aqua Green and not an attorney, may not represent the utility. On March 11, 2026, you entered an appearance on behalf of Aqua Green. However, since you became the attorney of record in this docket, Mr. Kendall has continued to make several filings in the docket on behalf of Aqua Green.

If you are no longer the attorney for Aqua Green, the utility must obtain other legal representation by an attorney licensed to practice in the State of Tennessee or otherwise admitted pro hac vice in the above referenced docket. As I have explained to Mr. Kendall in previous dockets as well, he cannot represent Aqua Green.
