On February 13, 2026, Garrad Johnson, PE, a wastewater engineer with T-Square Engineering, filed a Petition for a CCN Determination on behalf of Family Stations, Inc. (“Family Stations”). A non-lawyer, who is not a corporate officer of Family Stations may not represent Family Stations in this matter.

In this type of informal matter, Family Stations may file a letter on its own behalf, or it must hire an attorney as its representative. If a letter requesting a CCN determination filed by a corporate officer of Family Stations **or** an entry of appearance filed by an attorney authorized to practice law in Tennessee is not filed in this docket **by May 14, 2026**, this matter will be dismissed without prejudice, and the docket will be administratively closed.
