Proposed Procedural Schedule


The ISHA Foundation, Inc., (“ISHA” or “Petitioner”) respectfully requests that the Hearing Officer issue a procedural schedule for the expeditious handling of this docket.

Many of the facts and circumstances of this Petition have been set forth in three, prior proceedings involving ISHA, TPUC dockets 22-00099, 24-00077, and 25-00018. There were no intervenors in any of those dockets. In this case, there are, to counsel’s knowledge, no disputed facts, and the issues presented are questions of law. Moreover, counsel for Petitioner has sent copies of the Petition to the Consumer Advocate and to the Warren County Utility District (“WCUD”) and has discussed the Petition with both. Counsel for WCUD has stated that his client is not going to intervene. The Consumer Advocate is still considering whether or not to intervene but, as noted, did not intervene in any of the prior ISHA petitions. Consequently, it appears unlikely that there will be any intervenors and no need for a live hearing unless requested by the Hearing Officer.

In light of these circumstances, counsel for Petitioner suggests the following procedural schedule which, of course, should be amended if there are, in fact, any intervenors.

Filing of Petition.....April 21, 2026
Petitions to Intervene.....May 1, 2026
Discovery from Staff.....May 6, 2026
Responses to Discovery.....May 13, 2026
Pre-hearing conferenceMay 15, 2026
Hearing (if needed).....May 20, 2026
