**ORDER GRANTING CONSUMER ADVOCATE'S
MOTION TO AMEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This matter is before the Administrative Judge of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “TPUC”) on the *Consumer Advocate’s Motion to Amend Procedural Schedule* (“*Motion*”) filed by the Consumer Advocate Division of the Office of the Tennessee Attorney General (“Consumer Advocate”) on August 4, 2026. The *Motion* seeks to amend the Procedural Schedule in this matter to move the assigned date for the filing of the Consumer Advocate’s Second Discovery requests from August 6, 2026, to August 7, 2026, and to move the assigned date for the filing of the corresponding Responses to the Consumer Advocate’s Second Discovery Requests from August 21, 2026, to August 24, 2026. The *Motion* states that Limestone Water Utility Operating Company, LLC, (“Limestone”) does not oppose the *Motion*.

The effectiveness of a Procedural Schedule directly depends on cooperation by the parties in meeting the individual benchmark dates. The parties have agreed to adjust the dates for two filing deadlines by one business day due to better accommodate filing deadlines in other matters. The Administrative Judge finds the agreement to be reasonable and that it will not impair the progress of the case.

Based on the agreements made by the Consumer Advocate and Limestone regarding the adjustment to the Procedural Schedule, the Administrative Judge grants the Consumer Advocate's *Motion* and amends the Procedural Schedule as requested. The Amended Procedural Schedule is attached as **Exhibit A** to this Order and incorporated herein.

- All spreadsheets shall be filed in Excel format with working formulas intact.
- Any Pre-filed Testimony should include all supporting worksheets in Excel format with working formulas intact.
- Rebuttal Testimony should be limited only to issues raised in the Consumer Advocate's Direct Testimony and should include the page and line number of the Consumer Advocate's testimony that is being rebutted.
