Dear Mr. Malone:

On July 30, 2026, Limestone responded to the first-round discovery requests of the Consumer Advocate. Two discovery requests, 1-8 and 1-9, concerned the Company's proposed plant upgrades to the neighboring system, Candlewood, that were discussed in pre-filed testimony in the 24-00044 rate case. In response to the respective discovery requests, the Company indicated that the purchase of a generator and work on the well drilling were scheduled for August 2026. The Consumer Advocate requests an update to the Company's discovery responses indicating the progress made on the plant upgrades.

The Consumer Advocate requests additional updates on the status of two additional supplemental answers the Company has committed to providing to the Consumer Advocate discovery requests 2-10 and 2-11 which concern potential future customers. The Company's response filed on August 24, 2026, indicated Limestone would request such information from the City of Grand Junction.

The procedural schedule in this matter requires the Consumer Advocate to file pre-filed testimony on September 10, 2026. We appreciate your commitment to timely supplement the aforementioned discovery responses in order to keep this matter on schedule.
