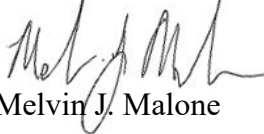

Customer Notification Letter

Dear Current Customer of Saulsbury – Grand Junction Water System,

Limestone Water Utility Operating Company, LLC (“Limestone Water”) and the City of Grand Junction (“Grand Junction”) have filed a Joint Application with the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“TPUC” or “Commission”) seeking Commission authorization for Grand Junction to sell to Limestone Water the assets used to provide regulated water service to customers of the Saulsbury Utility System in the City of Saulsbury, Tennessee. Grand Junction is currently serving approximately 231 connections in Hardeman County.

If the proposal is approved by the TPUC, Limestone Water will be subject to the jurisdiction of the TPUC in the following additional service areas:

- The City of Saulsbury

Limestone Water has proposed to the Commission that Limestone Water would adopt the existing base water rates currently charged by Grand Junction, so the base rates would remain the same. Other existing Grand Junction rates and charges and those same and additional rates and charges proposed by Limestone Water if the acquisition is approved are outlined below:

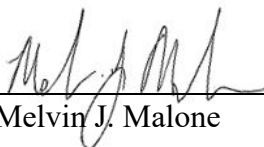
