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I. INTRODUCTION AND REQUEST FOR AUTHORITY

1. Applicant ("SCR Network Inc.") respectfully seeks a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity authorizing it to provide competing local exchange telecommunications services in the State of Tennessee. SCR Network Inc.'s service model is a managed hosted Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) model directed primarily to business customers that require reliable, business-grade, IP-based telephone service.
2. SCR Network Inc. requests statewide authority within Tennessee. Although the company's initial growth is expected to occur within its existing customer relationships and current operating footprint, statewide authority is appropriate because it would allow SCR Network Inc. to respond to customer demand throughout Tennessee without the need for repeated amendments or piecemeal authority requests.
3. SCR Network Inc. is not asking the Commission to approve a speculative facilities build, an unproven business concept, or a highly leveraged market entry. SCR Network Inc. already operates a managed technology and communications business, owns and uses telecommunications-related equipment in ongoing operations, and proposes a conservative growth model supported by positive monthly cash flow and available supplemental liquidity.
4. SCR Network Inc. understands that the Commission considers whether the grant of authority will serve the present or future public convenience and necessity and whether the SCR Network Inc. has demonstrated sufficient managerial, technical, and financial ability to provide the proposed services. This Application is organized to address each of those considerations directly and completely.

II. SCR Network Inc. INFORMATION AND CORPORATE STRUCTURE

1. SCR Network Inc.'s legal name is SCR Network Inc. SCR Network Inc.'s principal business address is 88 DeBruce Rd., Camden, Tennessee 38320. SCR Network Inc.'s primary business telephone number is 1-731-213-2255, its principal email address is scott@scrnetwork.com, and its website is scrnetwork.com.
2. SCR Network Inc. is wholly owned by Scott Hill, who holds a one hundred percent (100%) ownership interest in the company and serves as the owner and operator of the business.
3. SCR Network Inc. has a simple and direct operating structure. It is not part of a multilayered holding-company arrangement and has no disclosed parent corporation. Operationally, the company is led by its owner and supported by four independent contractors as needed. This structure allows decision-making to remain direct, keeps overhead controlled, and allows staffing to scale with demand.
4. SCR Network Inc. will include with the filing package the corporate and administrative materials ordinarily associated with a Tennessee telecommunications application, including organizational or formation documents and proof of authority to do business in Tennessee, to the extent such items are required by the Commission's filing instructions.

III. SERVICES TO BE OFFERED AND PROPOSED SERVICE AREA

1. SCR Network Inc. proposes to offer hosted VoIP telecommunications services to business customers. The service includes Direct Inward Dial (DID) voice service, inbound and outbound calling, hosted PBX functionality, call routing, voicemail, and related business telephony features commonly associated with a managed hosted voice platform.
2. SCR Network Inc. does not presently offer standalone SIP trunking service to customer-owned PBX systems as a separate retail or wholesale telecommunications product. Instead, SCR Network Inc.'s service offering is a managed hosted solution in which numbering, routing, voice connectivity, and PBX functionality are delivered together as part

of SCR Network Inc.'s own managed service environment.

3. SCR Network Inc. also supports customer transitions from legacy systems and can deploy appropriate analog interface equipment, including FXO/ATA solutions, where needed to interoperate with certain existing customer equipment during migration to IP-based voice services.

4. SCR Network Inc. is not requesting authority in this filing for retail SMS service because that offering remains under development. SCR Network Inc.'s current plan is to develop an API-connected web-portal-based SMS environment for end users in the future. If and when that service is launched, SCR Network Inc. will ensure that it is offered in a manner consistent with applicable legal and regulatory requirements.

5. SCR Network Inc. seeks statewide authority throughout Tennessee. The company expects initial growth to remain measured and demand-driven, but statewide authority is the most practical and efficient approach for a certificated telecommunications provider.

IV. PUBLIC INTEREST AND COMPLIANCE WITH COMMISSION STANDARDS

1. Granting the requested certificate will serve the present and future public convenience and necessity by increasing the availability of competitively priced managed business voice service in Tennessee. Tennessee businesses continue to require reliable hosted telephony options that can replace or integrate with legacy systems while preserving business continuity and access to business communications features.

2. SCR Network Inc.'s operating model is intentionally conservative. The company is not dependent on the deployment of traditional outside plant or on large speculative capital expenditures. Its services are delivered through managed IP-based systems, upstream carrier relationships, and owned telecommunications equipment. That model reduces capital intensity while still allowing the company to provide service responsibly.

3. SCR Network Inc. affirms that it is willing to comply with applicable Commission policies, rules, orders, and service standards governing telecommunications service in Tennessee, including applicable customer-protection obligations, service-quality obligations, and rules governing disconnection and reconnection of service.

4. SCR Network Inc. further states that its service will be provisioned and maintained in a manner that will not impair the statewide public switched telephone network. SCR Network Inc. will use standard telecommunications operating practices and appropriate upstream carrier relationships to support reliable call completion and service interoperability.

V. MANAGERIAL QUALIFICATIONS

1. SCR Network Inc.'s managerial qualifications are centered in its owner, Scott Hill. Mr. Hill has approximately ten (10) years of experience in telecommunications and approximately eighteen (18) years of experience in information technology and networking. That combination of experience is directly relevant to the management of a hosted VoIP telecommunications business.

2. Mr. Hill's prior work includes telecommunications system deployment, managed communications support, networking, systems administration, and disaster recovery. Importantly, his work history also includes installation of Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) and 911 dispatch-related systems. That background gives SCR Network Inc. a practical understanding of the importance of service reliability, emergency calling, and the consequences of telecommunications failure in critical environments.

3. SCR Network Inc. currently operates a managed service provider (MSP) business that supports business customers with recurring technology services. The ongoing operation of that MSP business demonstrates management

capability, customer support continuity, billing discipline, vendor coordination, and the ability to maintain recurring service relationships.

4. SCR Network Inc.'s staffing model is intentionally lean. In addition to the owner/operator, the company uses four independent contractors. That structure allows the company to scale labor expense according to demand and to avoid unnecessary fixed overhead that could otherwise weaken the business during slower growth periods.

5. Mr. Hill's professional credentials include CompTIA A+, Network+, iNet+, Project Manger+, and Security+ certifications, a WatchGuard certification, and a Bachelor of Science degree in Computer Science. Those qualifications complement his operational experience and support SCR Network Inc.'s ability to manage telecommunications services responsibly and competently.

6. SCR Network Inc. also notes that Mr. Hill has prior law-enforcement experience. SCR Network Inc. does not rely on that background as a substitute for telecommunications expertise, but it is relevant because it supports familiarity with lawful process, compliance discipline, and the responsible handling of sensitive communications matters.

VI. TECHNICAL QUALIFICATIONS

1. SCR Network Inc. possesses the technical ability to provide the proposed hosted VoIP services. Mr. Hill has owned and operated managed PBX systems and associated network equipment used to deliver IP-based voice services, and has extensive knowledge related to said-same products.

2. SCR Network Inc. owns approximately \$30,000 in telecommunications and networking equipment used in operations, including servers, PBX systems, firewalls, and related network equipment. This existing asset base demonstrates that SCR Network Inc. is an operating communications business with real systems in place rather than a paper-only applicant.

3. SCR Network Inc.'s architecture is based on modern IP-based telecommunications rather than traditional outside plant such as copper loops, poles, or towers. That operating model reduces fixed capital requirements, limits exposure to infrastructure debt, and allows service expansion to occur incrementally through prudent scaling of systems and carrier resources.

4. Although SCR Network Inc. does not market standalone SIP trunking as a distinct product, it has the technical competence to configure and manage trunking, signaling, routing, and associated connectivity inside its hosted PBX environment as part of the managed service it provides to customers.

5. Where customers are migrating from legacy telephony environments, SCR Network Inc. can support interoperability through the deployment of analog interface equipment such as FXO/ATA devices and related gateway components. This technical capability reduces migration friction and helps preserve continuity for customers with existing equipment.

6. SCR Network Inc.'s owner has direct prior experience with PSAP and 911-related installations. That experience materially strengthens the company's understanding of emergency calling environments and informs its approach to E911 support, routing sensitivity, and service reliability.

7. SCR Network Inc.'s service model is technically scalable. Because service is delivered through managed systems, familiar platforms, and upstream carrier resources rather than through speculative network construction, growth can be controlled and technical resources can be increased in step with demand.

VII. REGULATORY COMPLIANCE

1. SCR Network Inc. affirms that it will adhere to all applicable Commission statutes, policies, rules, and orders governing telecommunications providers in Tennessee.

2. SCR Network Inc. is E911 compliant and treats emergency-calling compliance as a serious operational obligation. SCR Network Inc.'s E911 posture is strengthened by the owner's prior direct work on PSAP and 911 dispatch-related installations, which gives the company a grounded understanding of emergency communications handling and the importance of accurate routing and reliability.
3. SCR Network Inc. also acknowledges its obligations under the Communications Assistance for Law Enforcement Act (CALEA) and affirms that it is CALEA compliant. SCR Network Inc.'s network architecture and upstream carrier relationships support lawful intercept compliance when legally required and properly authorized.
4. SCR Network Inc. further states that it is compliant with applicable FCC and USAC obligations associated with its operations.
5. SCR Network Inc. will cooperate with lawful regulatory and law-enforcement processes in accordance with applicable law and will maintain service in a manner consistent with public interest and consumer protection requirements.

VIII. FINANCIAL QUALIFICATIONS

1. SCR Network's financial qualifications should be evaluated in light of its existing operating business, positive monthly cash flow, conservative growth model, owned equipment base, and available supplemental capital. SCR Network is a small but established technology and communications operator, not a speculative entrant without operating revenue.
2. SCR Network Inc.'s existing MSP operations generate average monthly revenue of approximately \$39,000 and average monthly expenses of approximately \$34,000, yielding approximately \$5,000 in monthly net operating income from the MSP side of the business.
3. SCR Network Inc. projects telecommunications revenue of approximately \$8,000 per month with telecommunications-related expenses of approximately \$7,000 per month, yielding approximately \$1,000 in monthly net operating income from the telecommunications side of the business under present conservative assumptions.
4. On a combined basis, SCR Network Inc. presently operates with approximately \$47,000 in monthly revenue, approximately \$41,000 in monthly expense, and approximately \$6,000 in positive monthly net operating income. SCR Network Inc. is operating on a positive cash-flow basis rather than relying on an unfunded or purely speculative launch.
5. SCR Network Inc. candidly acknowledges that it operates on a lean month-to-month basis rather than with oversized idle cash reserves. However, the absence of large reserve balances does not equate to financial instability. SCR Network Inc.'s financial risk is mitigated by recurring revenue, a lean expense structure, contractor-based staffing flexibility, owned operational equipment, and a service model whose costs scale with demand.
6. Most significantly, SCR Network Inc. has access to an established home-equity line of credit maintained by its owner in the approximate amount of \$240,000. The line of credit is currently available and is not presently being utilized. SCR Network Inc. does not rely on that line of credit for routine operations; rather, it serves as a significant liquidity backstop that can be used if necessary to support continuity of service, absorb temporary revenue fluctuations, or address unforeseen operational demands.
7. SCR Network Inc. therefore submits that it possesses sufficient financial ability to provide the proposed services, not only at launch but on an ongoing basis. Exhibits A through C provide projections and summary financial presentations.

A. 12-Month Projection Narrative

SCR Network Inc.'s 12-month projection is intentionally conservative. Telecommunications revenue is expected to

remain near the current ~\$8,000 monthly level, with only slow and steady growth over the projection horizon. Expenses are also expected to rise gradually because certain carrier, licensing, and support costs scale with customer count and usage. Even under this conservative model, telecommunications operations remain modestly profitable and combined company operations remain clearly cash-flow positive.

B. Continuity of Service

SCR Network Inc. understands the Commission's central concern in reviewing financial fitness is whether customers are likely to face service disruption from business failure or undercapitalization. SCR Network Inc.'s structure directly mitigates that risk. SCR Network Inc. already operates an established recurring-revenue MSP business; its telecommunications offering is managed and scalable rather than capital-intensive; the company owns relevant operating equipment; and the owner has access to a substantial available line of credit. For those reasons, SCR Network Inc. has the financial ability not merely to begin service, but to continue service without unreasonable risk of interruption.

IX. RATES AND CHARGES

1. SCR Network Inc.'s current hosted VoIP rate is \$35.00 per month per DID. That rate includes standard voice service and access to hosted PBX functionality associated with SCR Network Inc.'s managed business voice platform.
2. Additional equipment, custom configurations, implementation work, and project-specific services may be priced separately depending on the needs of the customer. SCR Network Inc. will assess and disclose taxes, fees, and charges in accordance with applicable law and regulation.
3. As previously noted, SMS service is not currently being offered under this application.

X. SMALL AND MINORITY-OWNED TELECOMMUNICATIONS BUSINESS PARTICIPATION PLAN

1. SCR Network Inc. acknowledges Tennessee's policy favoring participation by qualified small and minority-owned telecommunications businesses in the provision of goods and services to telecommunications providers.
2. SCR Network Inc. will make good-faith efforts, proportionate to the size of its business, to identify, solicit, and use qualified small and minority-owned businesses where commercially reasonable and operationally appropriate. These efforts may include identifying vendors and subcontractors, requesting quotations where feasible, maintaining records of outreach, and considering qualified businesses for future procurement opportunities.
3. Because SCR Network Inc. is a small, owner-managed company with a modest procurement footprint, the scale of its purchasing activity is limited. Nevertheless, SCR Network Inc. commits to implementing the foregoing good-faith participation approach in a manner consistent with the scope of its operations.

XI. TENNESSEE-SPECIFIC OPERATIONAL CONSIDERATIONS

1. Intra-County Calling Requirements: In accordance with Tennessee Code § 65-21-114, SCR Network Inc. does not impose distance-based toll charges for calls placed within the same county. The Company's standard VoIP services are offered on a flat-rate basis and do not utilize per-minute or distance-based billing. As such, customers are not charged additional fees based on the geographic location of calls within the same county, ensuring full compliance with Tennessee law governing intra-county calling.
2. Emergency Service (E911): SCR Network Inc. provides Enhanced 911 (E911) capabilities consistent with all applicable federal and state requirements. Emergency calls are routed to the appropriate Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP), and accurate location information is maintained and transmitted as required. The Company's owner has

prior professional experience in the installation and support of 911 dispatch systems (PSAP environments), providing a strong operational understanding of emergency communications infrastructure. This experience supports the Company's commitment to reliable and compliant E911 service delivery.

3. Consumer Protection and Billing Practices: SCR Network Inc. employs transparent and straightforward billing practices. Telecommunications services are offered on a flat-rate basis, and customers are not subject to distance-based toll charges. All rates, fees, and applicable taxes are clearly disclosed to customers. The Company does not engage in deceptive billing practices and maintains clear communication regarding service terms, pricing, and any applicable conditions.

4. Service Reliability and Continuity: SCR Network Inc. operates a managed, IP-based telecommunications platform designed for reliability, scalability, and continuity of service. The Company maintains positive operating cash flow, low fixed overhead, and a scalable cost structure aligned with customer demand. In addition, the Company has access to supplemental capital resources, including an established line of credit, which may be utilized to support operations and ensure uninterrupted service in the event of unforeseen circumstances.

5. Compliance with Tennessee Regulatory Authority: SCR Network Inc. will comply with all applicable rules, regulations, and reporting requirements of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission. The Company acknowledges the Commission's authority over telecommunications providers operating within the State of Tennessee and will adhere to all applicable service obligations, regulatory requirements, and compliance standards.

XII. REQUEST FOR RELIEF

1. SCR Network Inc. respectfully requests that the Commission grant SCR Network Inc. a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity authorizing it to provide competing local exchange telecommunications services on a statewide basis within Tennessee.

2. SCR Network Inc. further requests such other, further, and general relief as the Commission deems proper.

EXHIBIT A

12-MONTH REVENUE AND EXPENSE PROJECTION

The following projection reflects the conservative growth assumption selected by SCR Network Inc.: slow and steady growth, with revenue remaining close to the present ~\$8,000 monthly level rather than increasing aggressively.

Month 1: Revenue \$8,000; Expense \$7,000; Net \$1,000.

Month 2: Revenue \$8,000; Expense \$7,000; Net \$1,000.

Month 3: Revenue \$8,100; Expense \$7,050; Net \$1,050.

Month 4: Revenue \$8,150; Expense \$7,100; Net \$1,050.

Month 5: Revenue \$8,200; Expense \$7,150; Net \$1,050.

Month 6: Revenue \$8,250; Expense \$7,200; Net \$1,050.

Month 7: Revenue \$8,350; Expense \$7,250; Net \$1,100.

Month 8: Revenue \$8,450; Expense \$7,300; Net \$1,150.

Month 9: Revenue \$8,550; Expense \$7,400; Net \$1,150.

Month 10: Revenue \$8,700; Expense \$7,500; Net \$1,200.

Month 11: Revenue \$8,850; Expense \$7,600; Net \$1,250.

Month 12: Revenue \$9,000; Expense \$7,700; Net \$1,300.

Projected annual telecommunications revenue under this model is \$100,600; projected annual telecommunications expense is \$87,250; and projected annual telecommunications net income is \$13,350.

EXHIBIT B

PRO FORMA INCOME STATEMENT AND CASH FLOW SUMMARY

- **MSP Revenue (Yearly):** \$468,000. Based on average monthly recurring MSP revenue.
- **MSP Expenses:** \$408,000. Based on average monthly MSP operating expense.
- **MSP Net Income:** \$60,000. Positive contribution from existing operations.
- **Projected Telecom Revenue:** \$100,600. From Exhibit A projection.
- **Projected Telecom Expense:** \$87,250. From Exhibit A projection.
- **Projected Telecom Net Income:** \$13,350. Conservative but positive.
- **Combined Projected Net Income:** \$73,350. MSP plus projected telecom result.

Current combined monthly operating profile: approximately \$47,000 in revenue, approximately \$41,000 in expense, and approximately \$6,000 in positive monthly net operating income.

Projected combined annual net income under the conservative model is \$73,350.

SCR Network Inc. expects cash flow to remain positive throughout the projection period. The owner's available \$240,000 line of credit provides supplemental liquidity in the event of an unexpected short-term cash need.

EXHIBIT C

BALANCE SHEET SUMMARY AND ACCESS TO CAPITAL

- **Owned operating equipment:** approximately ~\$30,000 in servers, PBX systems, firewalls, and related networking equipment used in operations.
- **Traditional outside plant infrastructure:** none. SCR Network Inc. does not rely on copper plant, towers, or similar legacy facilities.
- **Available line of credit:** \$240,000 available through an existing owner line of credit that is currently available and not presently drawn.
- **Current operating posture:** positive monthly cash flow, with approximately \$6,000 combined monthly net income on the present operating profile.
- **Debt posture:** lean operating model with no material infrastructure debt.

SCR Network Inc.'s balance-sheet presentation is intentionally conservative and summary in form. The principal takeaway is that SCR Network Inc. owns and uses meaningful operating equipment, is not burdened by heavy infrastructure financing, and has access to substantial available supplemental capital relative to the scale of its operations.

The available line of credit is not presented as a substitute for ordinary profitability. It is an additional safeguard that materially reduces the risk of service interruption resulting from temporary operating stress or unforeseen expense.

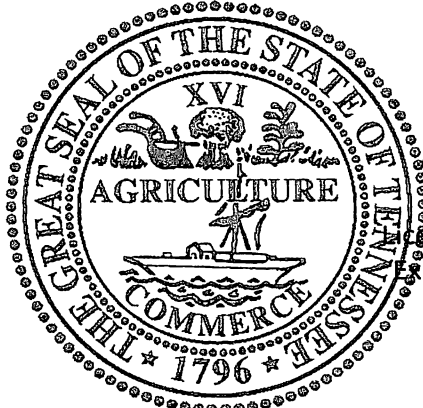
